MUMBAI: With continuous improvement and growth in cargo handling, Mumbai Port has moved to top three amongst the 12 Major Ports in the current fiscal 2016-17 i.e. upto December 2016. During the FY 2015-16 Mumbai Port was placed 4th.

During the calendar year 2016, a throughput of 62.38 MMT is recorded. Mumbai Port improved the performance almost in all the segments, it is present in. The phenomenal increase was seen in the area of automobile

handling when 2.06 lakhs vehicles passed through its shores as against 1.49 lakhs in the year 2015, registering a whopping growth of 38%. Record loading of 6312 vehicles on a single ship was achieved on 06.08.2016, surpassing the earlier figure of 5376 vehicles.
